The accompanying application is from an individual eligible for a work trial.

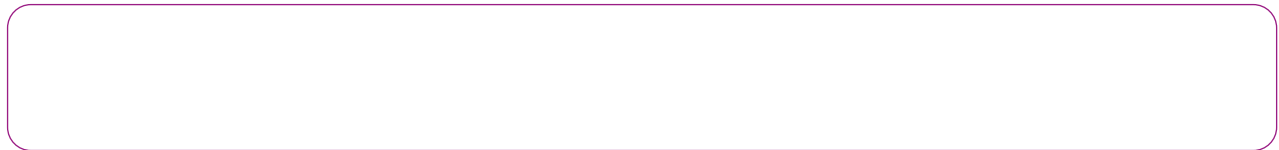
Work trials provide an opportunity for you to get to know the person and how they work rather than just relying on a short interview. A trial enables you to assess if the person is best suited to the role and to your company, before making a final decision.

Some of the benefits of work trials are:

- the chance to trial the individual before making a final decision
- no wage cost during the trial
- no fuss and minimum paperwork, and
- confidence you have chosen the right person for the job.

The applicant is eager to work and wants the chance to prove to you that they can do the job. During this time Jobcentre Plus would continue to pay their benefits so you would not have to pay them any wages. We would also pay certain customer expenses.
